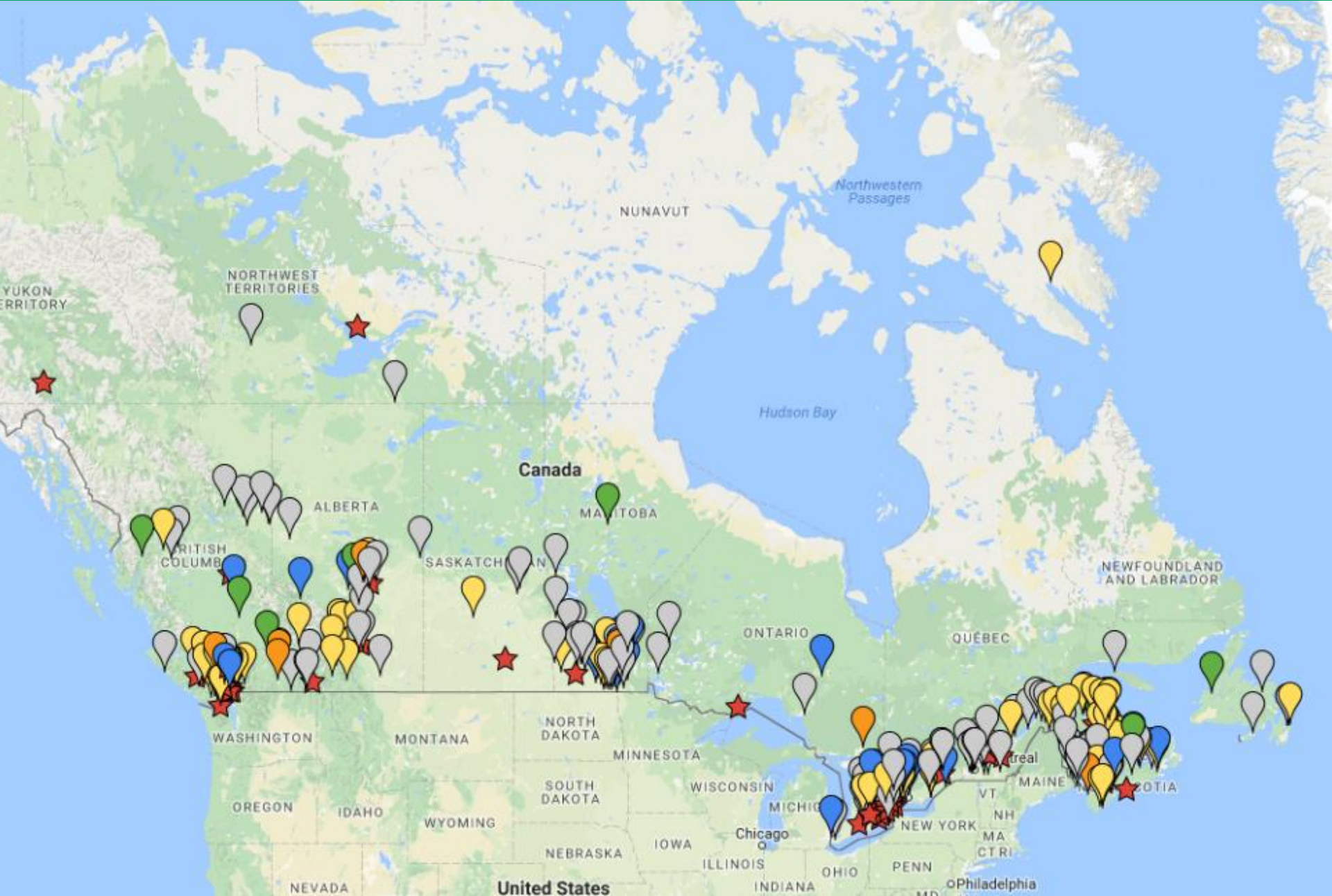

4. Implement the plan or set of activities



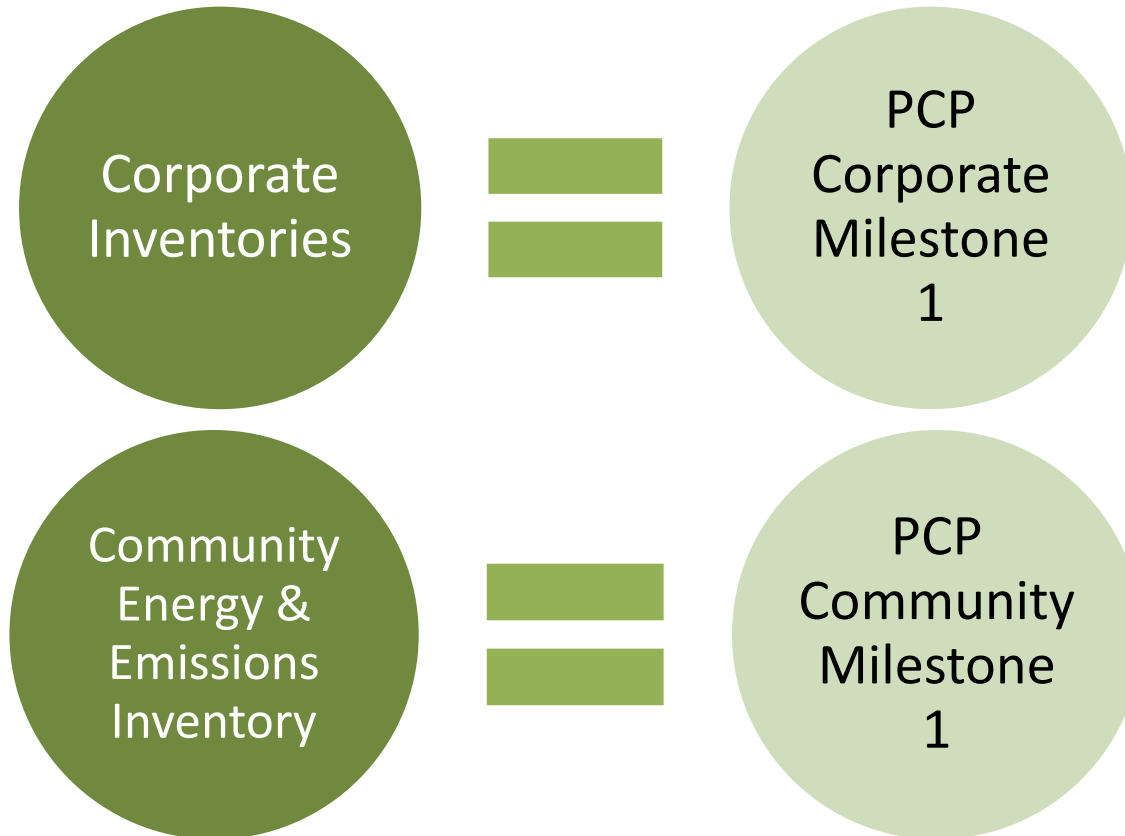
5. Monitor progress and report results

# How to Join...its free!

**Simple version:** Contact CEA, ask for help

- 2:** Designate 1 staff and 1 elected official to be the main contacts with PCP and adopt Council Resolution
- 3:** CEA can submit the adopted Council resolution to FCM
- 4:** CEA can coordinate with staff to prepare and submit milestone submissions to FCM

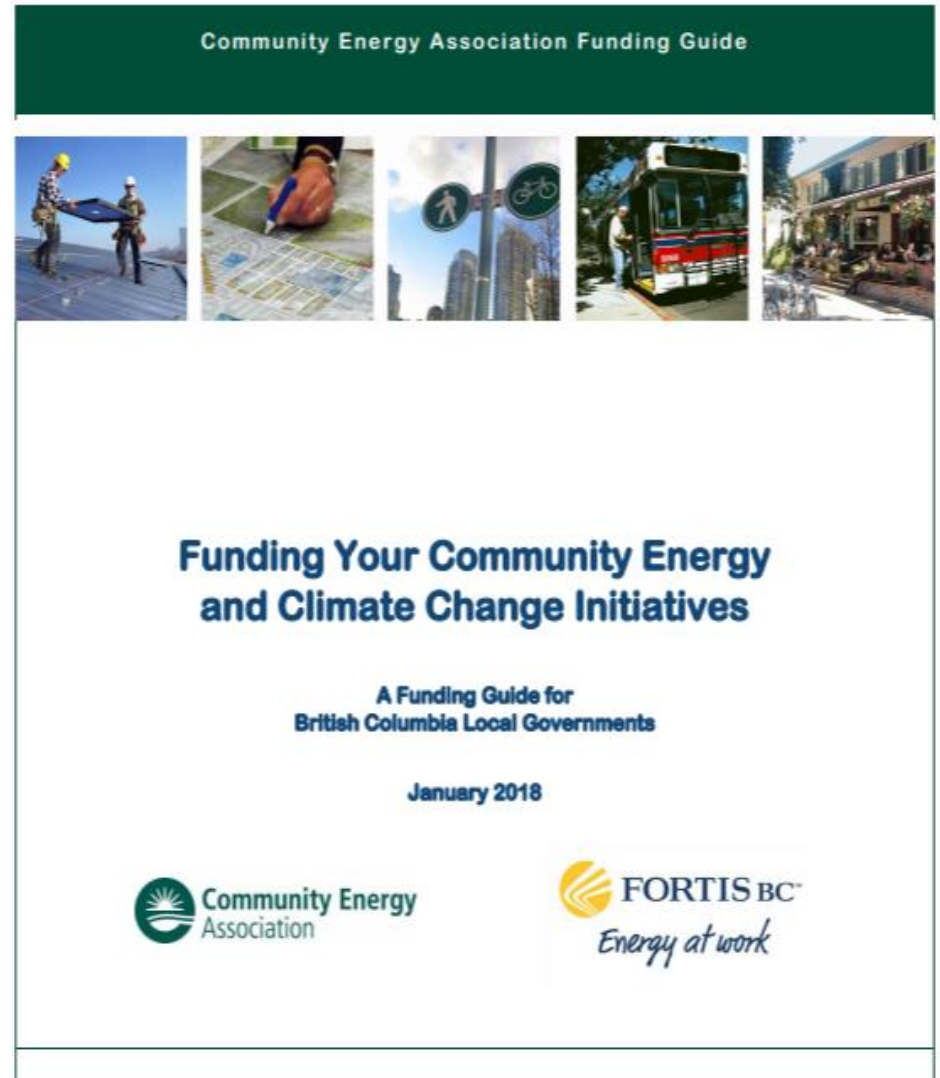

# Climate Change Staff Grants

- ▶ 80% salary costs up to \$125,000 over 2 years
- ▶ New or existing staff position to work on climate action specifically
- ▶ Apply by June 29, 2018



# Staff Initiatives

- ▶ Developing a climate mitigation or adaptation vision
- ▶ Implementing feasibility study or capital project
- ▶ Setting up a steering committee
- ▶ Preparing and holding public consultation



# Who can apply?

- ▶ Municipalities with a population of **150,000** or less
- ▶ **Two or more municipalities** that will share the services of one grant-funded staff person
- ▶ Indigenous communities that have a **shared service agreement** with a municipal government related to infrastructure, GHG emissions reduction or climate change



# Transition 2050 Partner Grants

- ▶ 80% grant up to \$400,000 over 3 years
- ▶ Minimum of 3 municipalities working together
- ▶ All must be PCP members and at least 1 at M5
